How do the digital workshops work?

- Out on location young people download and complete a treasure trail around a tourism destination
- In the classroom they discuss how to write great clues and record great audio and video content
- Out on location they follow an official guided tour
- Whilst on location they use their phones to take notes, photos and gather audio and video content
- In the classroom they learn how to operate the databases that drive the app. They refine, edit and enhance their content, then upload it into the database and publish
